With studios in Adams, Williamstown, and Bennington, we serve children, teens and families in over ten towns and cities. We offer nearly a dozen disciplines of dance and movement to all ages in both Berkshire and Bennington Counties, employing over a dozen faculty and staff. #### A message from our Co-Directors (from the show program):



Welcome parents, guardians, families, and friends to Berkshire Dance Theatre's presentation of *Bored in the House!* This year has been a whirlwind to say the least. We've spent the past year dancing in our living rooms, kitchens, bedrooms, guest rooms, outdoors, and attics. We've gotten used to the phrases, "You're on mute!" and "The music sounds like it's underwater," or "Sorry that's just my dog barking." We've curated our very first virtual showcase (despite having major technical difficulties) and learned how to interpret dance backwards and on the "wrong" legs and arms. Although we may have not been "bored in the house," it was certainly not the same as dancing in the studio with our friends!

The idea of this show theme came from the famous TikTok song, "Bored in the House." Those first few weeks of quarantine were rough, not knowing if we could leave our homes and how long the lockdown would be. So what did we do to pass the time? Played hide and seek, built a fort, challenged our families to a long game of Monopoly, watched TikTok for hours on end, had a friendly card game of Uno and War, or turned on the old Nintendo 64 and hurt our thumbs playing Mario Kart for too long, and so much more!

The year 2020 was certainly unprecedented, but it taught us so many things as an organization. It showed us the passion our dancers have to continue their craft even with all the challenges they faced and how talented they are by learning through Zoom for months straight. It proved how versatile and dedicated our faculty are in adapting to a new teaching format and their ability to roll with the punches. Most notably, it allowed us to reflect on what is truly important to us: the friendships, the camaraderie, the love we have for our dancers, and the support their families have shown through these hard times are at the root of why we have continued for 39 years, especially through the pandemic. We've come to find that it's not about the sparkly costumes and colorful lights, or the big stage and the make up, but about human connection. Sharing the stage with each other is one thing, but sharing a love for dance and continuing to create lifelong relationships with each other is the true core of our organization. We'd be nowhere without the people that make BDT what it is today.

To our faculty, you have been our rock. Not only are you all IT experts now, but you're also experts at going with the flow and working seamlessly through change after change. You've remained by our side when times got hard and never once thought about giving up. Without you, we have no dance classes. We have no happy children. We have no studio. Our gratitude for you all goes above and beyond any words that can possibly be expressed.

To our audience, you've stuck with us over this last year, and supported us by donating, volunteering, and most importantly, having faith that the studio would get back on its feet. #### Curriculum

The program at BDT is progressive and builds on the skills and experiences students acquire as they advance through the curriculum. Students in our Foundation level are placed according to general age guidelines. Transfer students begin at the lowest level appropriate for their age, and through the evaluation of the instructor, are placed at the correct class level in each discipline for their skill level.

Students are most successful when they start at the beginning of the program and work their way through it according to their own readiness and ability. Students advance according to ability and individual rates of progress. All placements are by teacher recommendation. We place our students in the classes where they will learn the most. Taking classes that are too difficult only promotes bad habits and poor technique, and often leads to frustration and discouragement.

## **Our Three Studios**

The studio in the historic Howland School at 46 Howland Ave. in Adams, is typically home to the upper level classes and the Company/Junior Company rehearsals. The Bennington studio, located at 120 Union St, typically features classes in children's programming and adult dance, in addition to beginner and intermediate programming. The Williamstown Studio is located at the Williamstown Youth Center and features classes for young ones.

#### Enrollment

As of February 2020, we had 237 students enrolled. After the shut-down in spring 2020, we were able to continue running 80% of our classes virtually. In the fall of 2020, our enrollment had dropped by 50% due to COVID-19 restrictions.

While the Theatre aims to keep the top quality dancers as instructors, it also tries to ensure that the instruction for community members is affordable. In addition, BDT provides financial aid through its Angel Fund, which endeavors to assist families in need so that their children can also take full advantage of BDT's programs.
